

**Lowhill Township
Board of Supervisors
Special Meeting
June 1, 2026
Meeting Minutes**

The Lowhill Township Board of Supervisors Special Meeting was called to order by Chairman Curtis Dietrich at 5:00 pm. Also present were Vice Chairman Michael Divers; Supervisor Jack Iannantuono; Township Manager Michael Siegel; Solicitor Rocco Beltrami, Esq.; and Secretary Jill Seymour.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, Michael Divers made the following motion: "Because the Commonwealth Court Opinion in the matter of Core5 at Route 100 vs. Lowhill Township and Lowhill Township Board of Supervisors, dated April 7, 2026, calls into question the validity of Supervisor Dietrich's votes made during the time from his initial appointment as Supervisor on November 10, 2022, by the Township's Vacancy Board, until the time of his appointment as a Supervisor by the Lehigh County Court of Common Pleas, by Order dated June 20, 2023, and with the clear understanding that the Township disagrees with the Commonwealth Court decision, dated April 7, 2026, on which the Township has requested re-argument and if necessary will appeal." Mike Divers made a motion to ratify all votes made by Mr. Dietrich and to ratify all actions of the Lowhill Township Board of Supervisors, made from November 10, 2022 through June 20, 2023. The motion was seconded by Jack Iannantuono. Roll call: All yes. Motion carried.

The floor was opened for public comment, hearing none, Curtis Dietrich made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Michael Divers.

The Lowhill Township Board of Supervisors meeting was adjourned at 5:15 pm.
