The minimum purchase amount for telephone quotes will increase from \$11,500 to \$11,800. The Kristofik settlement has gone through. The settlement is for \$4,000.

Engineer comments: None. The surety bond company for Ken Rauch is asking for sign off. Ryan Christman will fill out and send back. This is for the Bear Road Bridge.

The variance for 2951 Betz Court was approved for height at the Zoning Hearing last month.

Joseph Kalusky: December: Cleaned gutters, piped, had 2 days of salting, tiger mowed and did vehicle maintenance. For January, gutters and pipes will be cleaned again, more vehicle maintenance will be done, will work on potholes on dirt roads.

Fire department agreements will be signed in February. There has been nothing yet on the vacating of Poplar Road.

Richard Hughes made a motion to adopt resolution #2022-1 for User Fees with the following changes: Escrow for major subdivision and land development with multiple buildings of \$5000 over 10,000 sq. ft. and Zoning Hearing Board Fees \$750 for residential and \$1500 for commercial.
